All volunteers working with Liverpool Victoria Rowing Club are encouraged to behave to high standards and adopt recognised best practice where possible. In addition to their own standards of practice, volunteers should be aware of and adopt Liverpool Victoria Rowing Club's own:

- Safe from Harm Policy,
- Anti-Bullying Policy,
- Constitution,
- Safety & Safeguarding Guidelines.

In addition to British Rowing's:

- Code of Conduct (WG 1.4)
- Safeguarding and Protecting Children Policy,
- RowSafe,
