Merseyside Regatta at West Float, Wallasey/Birkenhead

Saturday 4th May 2019 (under British Rowing Rules of Racing and RowSafe)

1. Rules applying to this event

- 1.1 The event is run under British Rowing Rules of Racing, RowSafe and Adaptive Safety Guidance for Event Organisers:
- 1.2 On the day of the event, local rules for circulation will be in place and must be adhered to. All crews will come to the stage stern first and boat facing Lewis's Quay on the Wallasey side of the dock. Crews will then proceed to the start area on the Wallasey side and marshal beyond the start, which is on the Birkenhead side of the dock. The racing course is on the Birkenhead side of the dock. Crews will then proceed to the landing stage with their bows facing Lewis's Quay, or return to the start area on the Wallasey side.
- 1.3 Safety Boats will be stationed in the Finish/Stage area, at the Start and in the Start Marshalling area. In the event of an emergency or other incident, the Safety Boats may cross the racing course and, under the control of the Starter and oncourse Umpires, escort non-racing crews back to the boathouse along the racing course.
